

## English and Topic

This week, we have been combining our learning in English and topic to create a newspaper article about the Blitz in London. During our topic lessons, we have been researching the Blitz and empathising with the people of London and the trauma that was inflicted on them during the beginning of the war. 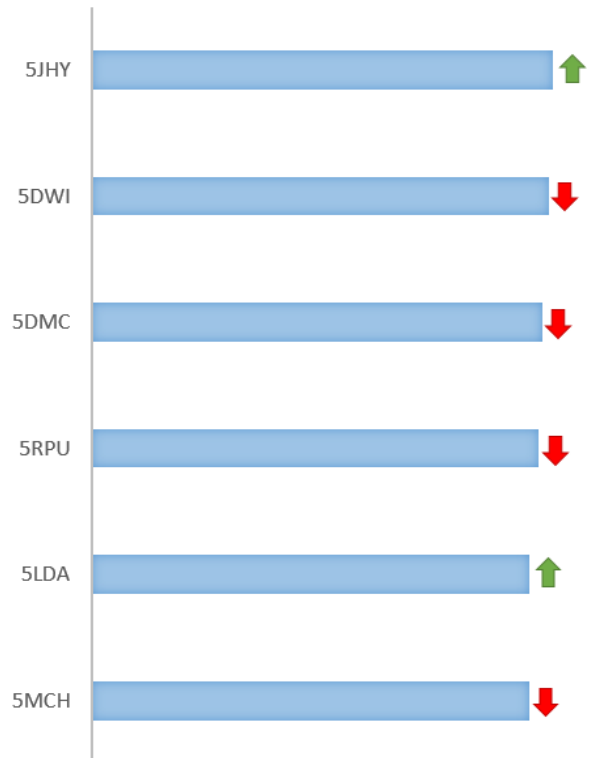
## Reminders
