English

In English, we have started reading Goodnight Mister Tom. The children are really enjoying it and it is linking very well with our topic work. They have been asked to write a diary entry as if they are William, the main character who has been evacuated to the countryside. The empathy and understanding the children have shown has been amazing and we are looking forward to reading the finished pieces.

Maths

Topic

The children have been investigation lots of different forces in their classes: up-thrust, water resistance, friction, gravity and air resistance.
