## Shrove Tuesday

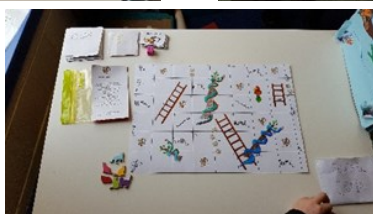

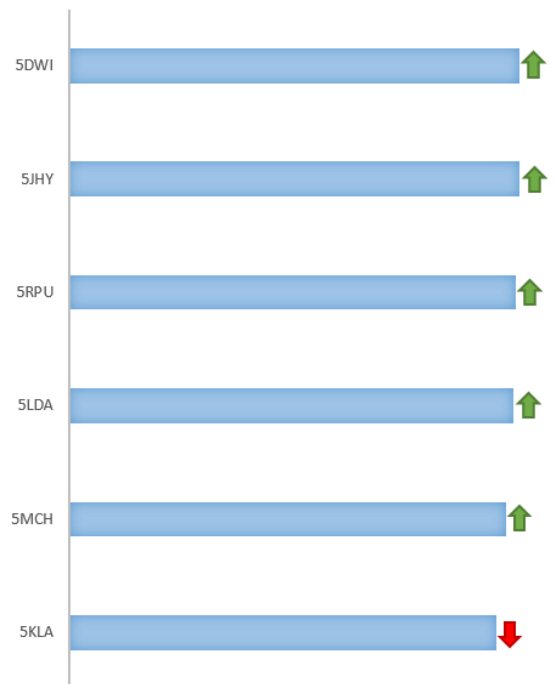


## Remember:
