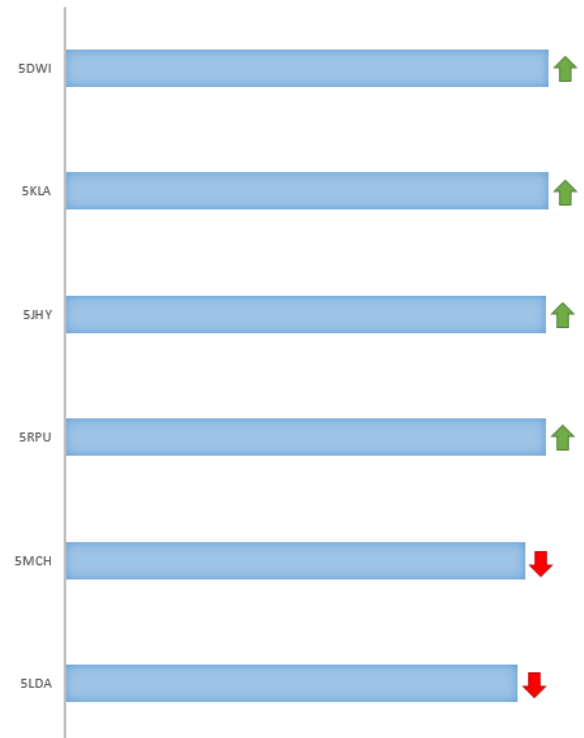
During the afternoons, we have started to gather knowledge about the Blitz in London in World War 2. On Tuesday 23rd May, Loudmouth, an educational theatre company, will be coming in to work with Year 5. They will be focussing on what a healthy relationship looks like and highlighting topics such as online safety, domestic abuse and following on from the NSPCC PANTS lessons that we taught earlier in the year. We will be calling this day 'Safety Day' and covering any topics that make your child feel unsafe. We will be doing a short survey with them next week to make sure we cover as many relevant topics for them as possible. There will be an assembly first thing in the morning for their theatre performance then each class will get a 30 minute workshop with the group leading on from the topics covered in the performance. All of these sessions will also involve their class teacher. Loudmouth is an excellent company who cover these topics sensitively for a younger audience – we are very lucky that they are able to come to our school.
