Mr McNidder and Mrs Bozward - 7th March

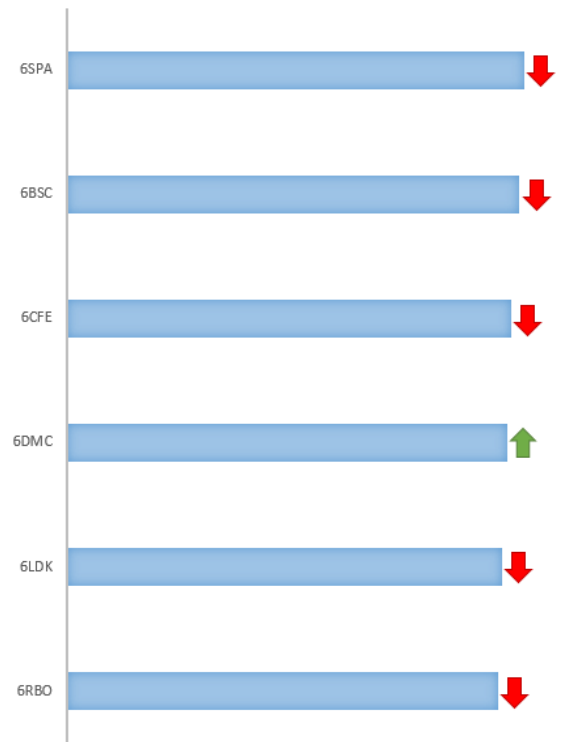
Miss Danckert and Miss Parker - 14th March
