

**Year 5 Trip – All Things Wild**

Dear Parent/Carer,

To end our Deadly Beasts topic, we have planned an amazing trip to All Things Wild for Year 5. All Things Wild is a nature centre situated in Honeybourne near Evesham. It has a growing collection of rare and exotic animals, birds, reptiles and the children will have the opportunity to see some of the animals they have been learning about in the classroom.

There will be an animal handling experience for all the children where they will learn about some of the animals and maybe get to hold them so please make us aware of any allergies or worries before our visit so we can accommodate them as best we can. All of the children will have an educational session, which will build on their prior learning of animal's lifecycles and habitats. All Things Wild also have 25 life-sized model dinosaurs and the children will follow the Dino trail finding clues about the dinosaurs to win a prize. The cost per child is £9.90, which covers entry, the animal handling session, the educational session, the coach and insurance. This will need to be paid via ParentPay by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March. All children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with a screw cap. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, lunch will be provided for them.

The children will not be required to wear their normal school uniform as the centre and the activities are based outside and they could get dirty. They will be required to **wear their PE top and a sensible pair of trousers that they will not mind getting dirty – jeans or joggers**. They **MUST** bring a **waterproof coat** with them as it could rain and many of the activities are outside. If they do not bring it to school on the morning of their trip, they may not be allowed to go, even if the weather is fine in Redditch. They must also wear sensible, waterproof shoes like trainers or boots. If wellies are needed, we will tell you closer to the time.

There will be a pocket money shop with items up to £2.00 on sale. The children can bring up to £5 maximum with them and it must be in a named purse or wallet and it will their responsibility to look after it throughout the day.

The trip will take place within school hours so all children will need to come to school at the normal time – 8.30am – and will be back in time to go home as normal. We will be leaving at 9.15am and returning by 3pm.

Please remember to make the payment by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2017 and fill in the consent form attached.
